Order

In light of the ongoing public health concerns relating to COVID-19, the deadlines to file the following documents concerning appeals before the Appellate Court are temporarily extended as follows:

1. The deadline to file a notice of appeal in the circuit court due on or after the date of this order is extended from 30 days to 60 days from the date of the circuit court judgment.
2. The deadline to file appellant and appellee briefs due on or after the date of this order is extended by 35 days, for a total of 70 days.
3. The deadline for filing a petition for rehearing due on or after the date of this order is extended by 21 days, for a total of 42 days.

These deadlines will remain in effect until further order of the Court.
